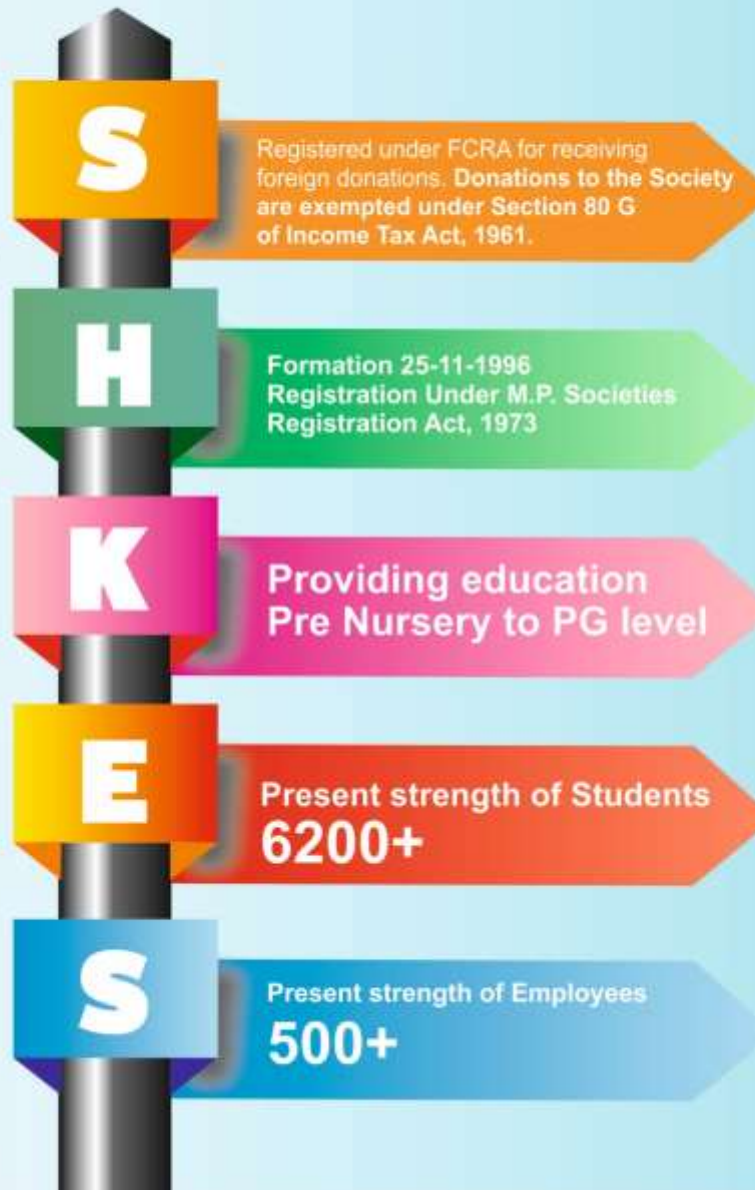
# SHAHEED HEMU KALANI EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY

- Tuition fees will be payable for 12 months.
- All fees, clubbed together, are payable quarterly, in advance, by the 10th of each quarter i.e. April, July, October and January.
